

The Bethel Training Centre was built by Miracles of God's provision and sacrificial investment of around 20 local and foreign churches under the leadership of Mark Harper from 2002-2014. Sadly, the organization responsible for the Centre allowed it to fall into disuse and decay, and is now defunct.

Mark says: "We once again feel the Lord's prompting to restore the BETHEL Centre for Kingdom purposes, run as a Training Ministry co-operative of churches, Missions organization's and like-minded individuals thus ensuring the continued use for the Kingdom."

Mark is excited to use his skills to restore the centre. It is envisioned that Bethel could serve for Skills Development Training of vulnerable kids and youth, Community Bible Study Training, Liveschool National Missionary Training, Youth Camps and Discipleship and more.

We are seeking "FRIENDS OF BETHEL" who will come to help practically, folks who will pray for and facilitate the financing of part of the renovation and ministry programs. An investment of USD60 per month covers a weekend training event, each month. USD170 monthly covers some ongoing maintenance as well as the practical training of a young person in practical handyman skills, Community Bible Study and the Re-Forma 'Certificate Biblical Training for Ministry' recognised by the Global Alliance of Evangelical

# PIONEER CHURCH PLANTING National Missionary Training Liveschool & Community Bible Study

Pioneer church planters and missionaries are encouraged by prayer, encouraging Scripture messages and sometimes supplying cell phones or airtime, transport, Bibles, translated audio or written Bible studies, Evangelism training and needed equipment. We try to encourage those heroes of faith, taking Christ's light in sometimes painful and hostile situations at great personal cost.

We use 2 amazing tools for mentoring Pioneer evangelists: World Missions Centre's LIVE SCHOOL 28-course video materials, which thoroughly prepare National Missionaries for reaching Least reached communities; and Community Bible Studies, whose verse by verse approach, enables new believers recently led to Jesus, to grow, be loved and nurtured in a safe space.

We train facilitators for visionary pastors to host and run their own Missions Schools under the Pro-Vision Umbrella. Join us in the GOD-GIVEN DREAM to see 1 000 Mozambican Missionaries trained in the next 5 years. To date 35 schools are functioning in 8 of the 10 provinces in Mozambique. Liveschool weekly practical outreaches have reached many least-reached communities including Muslim ones, with scores of Muslim-background believers baptised this year, despite the IS extremist attacks. These schools are functioning from Homes and Churches in some of the most difficult to reach areas of Mozambique. One of the facilitators is even reaching into the neighbouring country of Malawi.

Animism is the official religion of 45% of the population and witchcraft, fear and syncretism in some churches are rife - where people resort back to the witchdoctor in times of crisis while still attending church on Sundays. At the same time, God is performing miracles! A hunger exists in rural communities, to know God and His word - and audio Bibles and basic Community Bible Study materials have a huge impact.





Child Protection, Anti-trafficking and Caring for Orphans - God's 'Royal Treasures'

We equip churches and Christian teachers for Child Evangelism and Child protection & anti-trafficking — encouraging family based care through Orphan Sunday (a world-wide mobilization of Christian families to impact orphans through family care) and the Father's House network of safe fostering.

Since 2009, Royal Treasures, precious, chosen and immeasurably loved by our Heavenly Father, have been cared for, educated and spiritually and emotionally nurtured, first in YFC's Hope and Joy House, then since 2016, in 'Kaya ka Tatana' or 'Father's House'. Our three eldest next year will be completing degrees in Electrical Engineering, Secondary School Biology Teaching and 5th year Medicine, respectively.

We have two Primary school children from difficult places who need much healing from trauma. They need special help educationally, and our littlest girl, who slept outside under a hedge and foraged for food from local food gardens, has never been in school at the age of 12! She is a delightful child and it is a joy to teach her to read and prepare her to enter school in the 3rd grade next year.
